

## SCHOOL SUPPLY LIST

General School Supplies for each class: notebook (wide or narrow lined), loose-leaf paper, a 2-pocket folder, pens, pencils.

All students are encouraged to have a rectangular locker crate for locker organization. The dimension that fits in the locker is $14^{" \times} \times 15^{1 / 2 "} \times 11^{\prime \prime}$.

All students should cover each book that is assigned to them with either a flexible book cover or brown paper.
Science students will receive a school-issued lab book.
Culinary Arts 1 - Students will need a three-ring binder and loose-leaf paper.
All students enrolled in a math class are required to have the following:

- 1.5 inch or wider binder
- An adequate supply of loose-leaf paper
- Graph paper
- Dividers (for Algebra Essentials, all geometry classes and all calculus classes)
- 12-inch ruler
- Pencils and colored pen(s), not blue or black
- Calculator - for Algebra Essentials, Algebra 1, any geometry Class
- Graphing calculator - is required for students in classes that have completed a geometry class
- Protractor (preferably clear) for a geometry class

All students may use a graphing calculator. Students will be taught how to use a TI graphing calculator in math courses. These include any TI- 83 or TI- 84 calculator. Watch for back to school sales to get the calculators for as reasonable a price as possible. If you purchase a graphing calculator, please save the proof of purchase barcode and turn it into a math teacher at the beginning of the year. The Math Department is able to get free materials from Texas instruments with these barcodes.

## Spanish 1 and 2

- Loose leaf paper for notes
- One whiteboard marker to be donated to classroom supply
- One of the following to store all class handouts: pocket folder, a section in an expandable folder, or a 1" 3-ring binder


## Spanish 3, 4, 5

- Composition notebook
- One of the following: folder, section in binder, or section in an expandable folder that is dedicated for Spanish class

Additional supplies may be required for semester projects.
