Eligibility to Practice

- ❖ WIAA Physical Exam or Alternate Year Card
 - * papers in Atrium
- ❖ \$50 Participation Fee – Fees will be billed to your FACTS account.
- ❖ All paperwork electronically submitted

Transportation

- ❖ All athletes must use Roncalli transportation to away games unless they are played in Manitowoc.
- ❖ Parent signature on form for your child – coaches clipboard
- ❖ To get dropped off in route –
Brillion/Reedsville/Kewaunee/Sheboygan -note from parents before they get on the bus
 - ❖ Parents need to be present when dropping off

Misc.

- * Academics – WIAA
 - * receives no more than one failing grade in a grading period
 - * Ineligible for 15 days
- * Lockers
 - * Put bags and equipment in locker room – not in hallway
- * Absent and/or tardy to school
 - * School starts at 7:55 am - get to class on time
- * Parking - staff and faculty in the back - NO STUDENTS unless it is a tourney on a saturday morning

RAA

- ❖ Raises funds through athletic events, clothing, program sales, other functions etc.
- ❖ Annually they supplement the Athletic Departments budget to help pay officials, team bussing, monthly building upkeep - \$12,000

RAA

- * Special Requests from coaches for 2022-2023 school year - \$14,000 – besides the \$1,000 monthly to budget for gym upkeep
 - * fertilizer and aerating field out back
 - * HUDL – online video service for teams
 - * Conference Championship t-shirts for teams
 - * Coaches special requests

Eastern Wisconsin Event Passes

There are three different types of passes:

- * adult passes for \$55.00
- * student passes for \$25.00
- * family passes for \$135.00
 - * A family pass is good for parents and their own K-12 age students who show up at the gate together.
- * The Eastern Wisconsin also has a senior citizen pass. This pass is for anyone over the age of 62 and you will receive a complimentary pass
- * General Admission for conference games
 - k-12 \$3.00 / Adults \$5.00

Eastern Wisconsin Conference Event Passes

- ❖ Not good for WIAA tournament games
- ❖ All money stays at Roncalli when passes purchased at Roncalli
- ❖ Admission per event \$5
- ❖ Passes will be available at all home games or in the main office once school starts

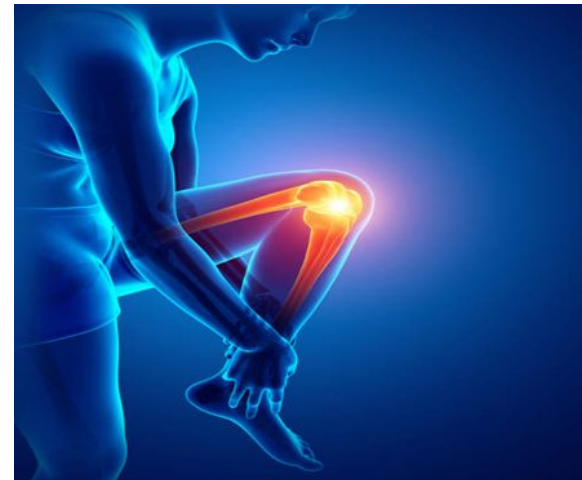
